Volunteer Staff Information

Thank you for your interest in helping at St. Sava Camp. We hope that the time you spend volunteering will be a positive and rewarding experience. Though an integral part of our camping program, volunteer staff have a role distinctly different from camp director, senior staff, and counselors. Volunteer staff take care of all the details that allow the camp directors, senior staff and counselors to do their work ministering to the campers.

Volunteers must be at least 23 years old and be in good health. Enjoy working as a part of a team, focusing on their specific responsibilities rather than the activities of the campers and staff. While we encourage parents to come with their children, please understand that in order to facilitate the camper's growth in a setting away from home and to allow them to be "campers," your interaction with your child will be limited. Questions or problems should always be referred to senior staff.

Listed below are some of the tasks our volunteers typically perform.

- All meal and snack preparation, setup and clean-up
- Dormitory housekeeping
- Assist with activity setup when requested
- Mop and sweep floors.
- Maintenance
- Laundry
- Assist with special projects as directed by camp director and/or senior staff.

Screening: please complete and return the Authorization for Background Check and Voluntary Disclosure and Release form included with the application. Our highest priority is the safety of our children.

Medical records: All participants must complete the Health Form, which can be downloaded from the website. Please bring the completed form with you when you arrive at camp.

Schedule: All volunteers will attend an orientation given by senior staff Sunday evening. Work assignments, volunteer guidelines, and the camp's schedule will be discussed at this time. The orientation provides an excellent opportunity for you to ask any questions/concerns.

Housing: Room and board are provided. Volunteers are housed in two dormitories, one for men and one for women. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate married couples in the same living quarters. The beds are single bunk beds, please bring your own bedding and towels.

Church services: if time permits, we encourage you to worship at Vespers.

We thank you for your willingness to serve our Church and our children in this demanding, but much appreciated effort.
