

Fr. Christopher is the rector of the St. Nicholas Serbian Orthodox Church. A graduate of Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, PA, where he earned a Bachelor of the Arts in Psychology and an English Literature Certificate, Fr. Chris loves to engage with the icons of Christ within each person he encounters.

During his undergraduate studies, Fr. Chris was a recipient of the Tamburitzan Scholarship, and performed with the Duquesne University Tamburitzans. After his undergraduate studies, with the blessing of His Grace, Bishop MITROPHAN, he attended St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary in Crestwood, NY, where he attained the degree of Master of Divinity, specializing in Pastoral Theology and Scriptural Studies, and recorded three albums for the famed SVS Octet.
